What data do we collect?

CLIMB.RUN collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)
- Personal activity data

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide CLIMB.RUN with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or upload a gpx activity.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies or session storage.

How will we use your data?

CLIMB.RUN collects your data so that we can:

- List your activities on the CLIMB.RUN website
 - Activities will be visible to other users of CLIMB.RUN if your profile is set to public.
- Calculate which mountains you have climbed for display on the CLIMB.RUN website.

How do we store your data?

CLIMB.RUN securely stores your data at the Ireland Amazon Web Services data centre.

Our Company will keep your personal records until you choose to remove them. If you choose to delete your account, your personal details will be removed within 24 hours. Activity details will be inaccessible after account deletion, and removed from the system within 7 days.

Marketing

CLIMB.RUN would like to send you information about our products and services.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop CLIMB.RUN from contacting you for marketing purposes.

If you no longer wish to be contacted for marketing purposes, please opt out via the CLIMB.RUN user preferences page.

What are your data protection rights?

CLIMB.RUN would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request CLIMB.RUN for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that CLIMB.RUN correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request CLIMB.RUN to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that CLIMB.RUN erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that CLIMB.RUN restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to CLIMB.RUN's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that CLIMB.RUN transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
